PURPOSE OF POSITION:

To participate in the work of small crew engaged in modification and repairs to sewer and water installations, and to provide general assistance to the Spare Crew Foreman.

DUTIES: (The duties described hereunder are intended to be representative of the position and are not to be considered as all-inclusive,)

Perform a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks such as: measuring, cutting, threading, coupling and installing pipe from ½" to 12" approximately, build concrete bases and slabs, shore excavations, install scaffolds, set up and align machinery and equipment, etc.

Assist Foreman in the supervision of work assignments and in the training and direction of new crew members and temporary help, pick up and selection of miscellaneous items, and keeps up to date with various supply sources.

Ensures that tools and equipment used by crew are in good condition and that safe working practices are adhered to.

Relieves Foreman during vacations, etc.

REQUIREMENTS: (Minimum to fill position.)

Grade 10. Valid B.C. Driver's Licence.

Requires demonstrated ability to plan works, read prints and obtain clean view of end results.

Demonstrated ability in the use of power and pneumatic tools, oxi-acetylene cutting, compressors, pumps, blowers, small gas engines, pipe cutting, threading and installation.

Requires demonstrated ability to work in enclosed and often dirty (sewage) areas.

Health certificate for watershed entry.
