Runs simple traverses and levels.

Record and reduce field notes neatly and accurately.

Maintain survey equipment in good order.

Submit time, mileage, material and equipment sheets for self and rodman when applicable.

REQUIREMENTS: (Minimum to fill position.)

Grade 12 (academic-technical) supplemented by courses in survey and survey computations.

Requires a minimum of one year's experience as Rodman "A", be physically fit for field work.

Possess valid BC driver's licence and health certificate for watershed entry.

Must be able to use surveyor's instruments such as transit, level, compass, hand level and angle prism.
